

shall actually cover, and the equipments owned by such corporations or institutions; all other property in this State of every kind, nature and description whatsoever, shall be liable to valuation, assessment and taxation; and all Acts, or parts of Acts, exempting any other property, except that exempted by this Act from valuation, assessment or taxation for State, county or municipal purposes, which can be repealed by this General Assembly, are to the extent of such exemption whenever or however the same has been heretofore granted, hereby expressly declared to be repealed to the extent of said exemption as aforesaid, and to be hereafter of no force or effect in granting such exemption.
