House bill entitled an Act to prevent Hogs and Geese from running at large in and within two miles of the village of Urbana, in Frederick county.

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay William B. Morgan, of Harford county, money for taxes erroneously paid by him into the Treasruy.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue the bonds of the City of Baltimore, to an amount not exceeding the sum of \$750,000, to provide means for extending and improving the Court House in said city.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Baltimore city Senators.
