1st. House bill entitled an Act to authorize George L. Michael, of Garrett county, to erect two gates on the public road in said county, leading through the farm of the said George L. Michael.

2d. House bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 8, of Article 1. of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany county," sub-title "Oakland," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue the bonds of the City of Baltimore to an amount not exceeding the sum of \$750,000, to provide means for extending and improving the Court House in said city.

Senate bill entitled an Act regulating the working and proper ventilation of coal mines in Allegany and Garrett counties, and providing for the appointment of an inspector for said mines.

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
