

NIGHT SESSION.

MONDAY, March 20th, 1876.

Senate met at 8 P. M.

Present at roll call the following Senators:

Messrs. Aydelotte, Bannon, Cooper, Freeman, Getty, Hepbron, Humphreys, Lee, Stevens, Steiner, Suit, Walsh—12.

The roll having been called, and a quorum not being present,

On motion by Mr. Suit,
