No. 67. An Act to repeal Section 164, of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Worcester county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

No. 68. An Act to revive and continue the Act to incorporate the Humane Impartial Society, and Aged Women's Home.

No 69. An Act to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Worcester county to appropriate money out of the free school fund of said county, towards building school-houses and for other purposes.

No. 71. An Act to incorporate the Maryland State Grange of the Order of Patrons of Husbandry.

No. 72. An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington county to fund certain indebtedness of the Board of County School Commissioners of Washington county, by issuing bonds therefor, and to levy a tax for the payment of the same.

No. 73. An Act to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Howard county to adjust and pay Thomas J. White for damages occasioned by opening a public road through his lands.

No. 74. An Act to repeal Section 1, of an Act passed at January Session, 1868, chapter 206, entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy a sum of money or issue bonds for repairing and altering the Court House in said county, and re-enact the same as amended.

No. 75. An Act to lay out and establish a new Election District in Queen Anne's county, to be called Ruthsburg District, or District No. 6.

No. 76. No. 77. An Act to protect and to prevent the destruction of the class of small birds known as insectiverous birds in St. Mary's county.
