AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Amend bill No: 102, by striking out "Section 2 and Section 3" and inserting in lieu thereof, the following:

Section 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Inspectors before entering upon the discharge of the duties of their office, shall give bond to the State of Maryland, in the sum of \$5,000, with good and sufficient security, to be approved by the Governor, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties imposed by the provisions of this Act, which bond shall be liable to be put in suit and for all damages for the breach of any of the provisions thereof, and shall be recorded in the Clerk's office of the Circuit Court of the county, or the Superior Court of the City of Baltimore as the case may be, and the said Inspector shall be allowed to charge and receive the sum of ten cents for each and every barrel of oil or fluid as aforesaid, to be paid by the purchaser thereof, and the said Inspectors shall each of them be paid the sum of _____ hundred dollars as annual salary commencing from the date of their appointment and qualification, the said salary to be paid out of the fees paid, and received for the inspection aforesaid."

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That said inspectors and each of them shall keep an accurate account in a book to be kept by them for that purpose, of the number of barrels of oil or fluid inspected by them as aforesaid, and the amount of fees received by them and each of them as aforesaid, and shall return an account of the same, verified by oath or affirmation, quarterly, to the Comptroller, and upon such return the Comptroller shall be authorized, and he is hereby directed, to allow to each of said inspectors the proportionate amount
