Mr. Cooper submitted the following amendment to the

Add at the end of Section next to the last, "That oils and fluids sold for exportation to foreign countries, shall not be inspected under the provisions of this Act."

Which was adopted.

The question recurring upon the amendment as amended, It was adopted.
