Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Consumers' Mutual Gas-Light Co. of Baltimore city.

On motion by Mr. Dennis,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations, to report a bill to incorporate the Maryland State Grange of the order of Patrons of Husbandry.

On motion by Mr. Getty,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 52, of the Acts of 1868, entitled an Act to repeal Section 45, of Article 29, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Circuit Courts for the counties," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to Messrs Hepbron, Knight and Ford, to introduce a bill to prevent splashing in the waters of Farley, Whorton, Churn and Still Pond creeks, and the Sassafra river and its tributaries.
