End of line 24, insert "and three Weighers who shall receive compensation at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum."

PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

Add to end of Sec. 1, "Provided that nothing in this Act shall be construed to exempt the property of this corporation from taxation.
