

and suitable ferry from Brooklyn to Baltimore city, or by building the bridge and roads thereto as provided in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, of this Act.

Section 7. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, be and they are hereby authorized, directed and required on or before October 1st, 1876, to take charge and possession of the bridge over Gwynn's Falls, known as Harman's bridge, according to the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, of 1867, chapter 94.

Section 8. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Section 1, line 5, strike out "first," and insert "twentieth."

Strike out Section 2, and amend by inserting the following:

"Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That nothing in this Act shall conflict with or repeal any of the provisions of the Act of 1874, chapter 466, relating to fisheries."
