The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and returned the following bills:

Senate bill entitled an Act to pay the claim of Medairy & Bowers.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays."

Senate bill entitled an Act to pay to Philip W. Downs and George M. Russum, a sum of money, for services rendered the State, in the case of the United States vs. Wm. H. Whitely.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 30, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, so far as the same Section relates to Worcester county.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 4, of chapter 104, of the Acts of 1862, entitled an Act to incorporate a Company for the establishment of a Public Cemetery in Kent county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays."

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 163, of the Acts of 1866, entitled "an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Federalsburg," and to substitute the following in lieu thereof.

Endorsed: "Passed by yeas and nays."
