Mr. Freeman submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"Provided, That all claimants shall show, to the satisfaction of the Comptroller, that their names were properly on the pension list, and were accidentally omitted or misspelt."

The vote by which said amendment was adopted,

Was reconsidered.

The question recurring again upon the adoption of the amendment,

It was adopted.

Mr. Bannon submitted the following amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Sec. 1, line 5, "Provided, that no person shall be entitled to a pension under this Act, unless they prove by two witnesses to the satisfaction of the Comptroller, that the applicant served in the war of 1812 and '14, or if a widow, she was the widow of a soldier of the war of 1812 and '14."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Brewer moved to indefinitely postpone the further consideration of said bill.
