No. 201. An Act to repeal an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Town of Church Hill, Queen Anne's county, State of Maryland, Art. 17, and Sections 65, 66 and 67, of the Code of Public Local Laws for Queen Anne's county, and to re-enact the following.

No. 220. An Act to establish a free bridge over the Patapsco river, at or near the present site of Light street bridge, and to provide for free travel from Anne Arundel county to Baltimore city.
