

Third. Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Farmer's National Bank of Annapolis, to pay over to the heirs of Samuel Gover, certain funds in said Bank due the said Samuel Gover's real estate.

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Stevens, from Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported unfavorably,

Senate bill to repeal Section 2, of chapter 504, of the Acts of 1874, entitled "an Act to regulate the manufacture and sale of oils for illuminating purposes," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was adopted.

Also, unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to add a Section to Art. 65, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Negligence," for the purpose of regulating the proof and effect of negligence in actions therefor under said Article, and at Common Law.

Mr. Dennis moved that said bill be substituted for the unfavorable report.
