Proceedings of yesterday read and approved.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates appeared and returned the following bills:

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the purchasers of the Kent County Railroad Company, and to allow said Company to be consolidated with the Smyrna and Delaware Bay Railroad Company.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to confer additional powers upon the County Commissioners of Garrett county.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy a sum of money as a pension for Solomon Tate of said county.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to enable Frances L. McDonald, and Mary J. Franklin, of England, to take and hold certain lands in Charles county, which were held by Frederick Dawson in trust.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Savage Manufacturing Company of Howard county, Maryland.

Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

Senate bill to repeal Sections 107, 108, 109, 110, 111 and 112, of chapter 483, of the Acts of 1874, relating to "Revenue and Taxes," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
