House bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, to pay a sum of money not exceeding \$3,000, to erect a bridge over Wye river in said county,

House bill entitled an additional supplement to an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Powhatan Baptist Church at Black Rock in Baltimore county.
