House bill in relation to public education, with the following endorsement:

"This bill coming to the Committee on Education in the afternoon of the last day of the Session, the Committee find it to be impossible to give that attention due so important a change in our present State School Law, as therein proposed.

"Therefore, it is reported back to the Senate, with recommendation that the bill be indefinitely postponed."
