

Chapter 3.

AN ACT for the payment of a sum of money to Eldridge W. Gallup, of Harford county, Maryland, for cattle destroyed under chapter four hundred and thirty-nine, acts 1880, Public Laws of Maryland, title "Pleura Pneumonia."

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the State be and he is hereby instructed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State for the sum of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars in compensation to him, the said Eldridge W. Gallup, in full for all claims for cattle destroyed and loss sustained thereby under chapter four hundred and thirty-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty. Compensation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That this act take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 4.

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled "An Act for the Protection of Fish in Middle river, Baltimore county," chapter ninety-five of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter ninety-five of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act for the Protection of Fish in Middle river, Baltimore county," be and the same is hereby repealed. Repealed.
