How construed.

Attorney amount to the sum of one thousand dollars in one year; and, provided further, that this act shall not be so construed as to include the fees and commissions of the said State's Attorney allowed

and paid by the State.

Account for services rendered.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the State's Attorney shall, at least ten days before the annual levy is made by the said County Commissioners, make out and present to the judge or judges aforesaid, for his or their inspection and approval, his account for services rendered during the fiscal year past, which account, when approved as aforesaid, shall be levied by the County Commissioners of Worcester county at the time of making the annual levy in each and every year.
SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That no compensation

for defending any party in any criminal case or cases shall be allowed to any attorney by the Commissioners of Worcester county, except on presentation of an order in writing, signed by a Judge of the Circuit Court for Worcester county, certifying in what case or cases services had been rendered, and the amount to be paid for such services.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

## Chapter 79.

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of the town of Oxford, in Talbot county, to construct a causeway.

Construct causeway.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Commissioners of the town of Oxford, in Talbot county, be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to construct a causeway to connect the said town with Stewarts or Town Island.

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
