Chapter 88.

AN ACT supplementary to the act of November session, eighteen hundred and twelve, chapter one hundred and fifty-nine, entitled "An Act for founding an University in the city or precincts of Baltimore, by the name of the University of Maryland," and authorizing the Regents of said University to grant Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates to Students of Dental Surgery, Pharmacy and other cognate branches of Medical Science in said University.

Issue diplomas

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Regents of the University of Maryland be and they are hereby authorized to admit to the degree of Doctor or Licentiate of Dental Surgery, Pharmacy or any other cognate branch or department of Medical Science, any of the students of the said University who, after having passed through such course of study and such examination as shall have been prescribed therefor by the Faculty of Physic of the same, shall be recommended by said Faculty to said Regents as meriting such degree; and the said Regents shall have power to issue diplomas and certificates of such admission to the said students in the same manner and form, and to the same effect prescribed and authorized by the thirteenth section of the act to which this is a supplement as to other degrees.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the degree of Doctor or Licentiate in Pharmacy, referred to in the first section of this act shall not be conferred upon any one who has not served an apprenticeship of
