Chapter 89.

AN ACT to change a portion of the dividing line between the fifth and sixth election districts of Garrett county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the present dividing line between the fifth and sixth election districts of Garrett county be changed so as to run as follows: Beginning at the head of the north fork of Casselmans river, in a straight line, to Lynns Sugar Camp, and from thence to the top of Negro mountain, intersecting the Grantsville and Oakland road, and from thence to present district line, near the west place.

Change of dividing line.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That after the passage of this act all voters within this line, who heretofore voted at Sang Run, in election district number six, shall, after having been duly registered upon the registration books of election district number five, be entitled to vote at all elections hereafter to be held at the town of Accident, in election district number five.

Where entitled to vote.
