

company or association, to sell directly or indirectly, at any place, or to give away at his, her, their, or its place of business, any spirituous, fermented, or intoxicating liquors of whatever origin, or alcoholic bitters, after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three; but if it shall appear by the returns of said judges of election and proclamation of the clerk of said court that a majority of the votes as prescribed in the third section of this act have been cast for the sale of intoxicating liquors then the same shall be sold as now permitted by law.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That if any person or persons, house, company, association or body corporate, shall sell directly or indirectly at any place, or give away at his, her, their or its place of business, any spirituous or fermented liquors or alcoholic bitters, or intoxicating drinks of any kind, within the limits of Harford county, on or after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty three, he, she or they shall, on conviction thereof, forfeit and pay on the first conviction a fine of not less than fifty dollars, nor more than three hundred dollars, and costs of prosecution; or, instead of such fine, imprisonment in the county jail for thirty days, or both in the discretion of the court; and on the second and every subsequent conviction not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars, and in addition to such fine, imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty nor more than ninety days, in the discretion of the court; and on failure to pay the fine, as herein described, he, she or they shall be committed to the county jail of Harford county until such fine and the costs are paid. One half of the fine imposed for any violation of this act shall go to the informer and the residue to the Board of County School Commissioners of said county, for the benefit of the public schools therein.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That no person, corporation, company or association shall deposit or have in his, her or its possession any spirituous or fermented liquors, or alcoholic bitters, or intoxicating liquors of any kind, with intent to sell or give away the same at his, her or its place of business, in violation of this law, or with intent that the same
