Chapter 8.

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to certain bequests in the last will and testament of Edward Buckey, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Frederick and to the Preachers' Aid Society of the Baltimore Annual Conference.

Sanction given

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sanction is hereby given to the following bequests contained in the last will and testament of Edward Buckey, late of Frederick county, deceased, which was admitted to probate in the Orphans' Court of Frederick county on the twentieth day of October, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, viz: The bequest of five hundred dollars to Asbury H. Hunt, John H. Keller, Milton G. Urner and William H. Falconer, trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Frederick, and their successors in office as trustees for said church, to be used in their corporate capacity for said church, and the bequest of four hundred dollars to the treasurer (or other officer authorized to receive it) for the Preachers' Aid Society of the Baltimore Annual Conference, for the use of said society.
