Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 94.

AN ACT to refund to Thomas Coddington, late Sheriff of Garrett county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.

Directed to draw warrant. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed and required to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer, to pay to the order of Thomas Coddington, late sheriff of Garrett county, as aforesaid, the sum of fifteen dollars, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury for and on account of fines, forfeitures and costs in State cases in said county.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 95.
