Chapter 97.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequests of David H. Shriver, late of Westminister, Carroll county, Maryland, deceased, of the sum of five hundred dollars each to the Trustees of the Methodist Protestant church and to the Trustees of St. Paul's Reformed church respectively, of Westminister, in said county and State.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction of the General Assembly is hereby given and declared to the respective bequests of David H. Shriver, late of Westminister, Carroll county, Maryland, deceased, of the sum of five hundred dollars, to the trustees of the Methodist Protestant church of Westminister, in said county and State, and of a like sum to the trustees of Saint Paul's Reformed church of said town, county and State.

Sanction given and declared.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 98.

AN ACT to repeal section four, chapter two hundred and seventy three, of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An Act to incorporate Bel-Air, in Harford county," and reenact the same with amendments, and to add two additional sections thereto, namely, number seventeen and eighteen.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section four of chapter two hundred and seventy-three of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, eighteen
