rant, any person or persons engaged in violating any of the ordinances of the town or disturbing the public peace, and shall, without unreasonable delay, take them before some justice of peace for trial.

Sec. 18 Be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of Harford county may, at their discretion, levy, annually, upon the assessable property of the county, and pay over to the treasurer of said town, the sum of one hundred dollars, to aid in keeping the streets of said town, as part of the public roads of the county, in good repair.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective.

## Chapter 99.

AN ACT to repeal, amend and re-enact section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two, passed at the January session, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty, for the better protection of Birds and Game in Wicomico county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section three of chapter four hundred and seventy-two, passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at the January session, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act for the better protection of birds and game in Wicomico county," be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons in Wicomico county to shoot, kill, take, trap or in any manner catch or destroy in said county, in any year, any of the birds or game within the different periods of time mentioned and specified in this section; that is to say, woodcock between the first day of January and the first day of September; plover (or sand pipers), partridges and quail, between the first of February and the first day of November; wood or summer
