

**Chapter 101.**

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-two of the Acts of Assembly, passed at January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An Act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws," to be entitled "Garrett county," and to re-enact the same with amendments providing for additional pay to the crier of the Circuit Court.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-two of chapter one hundred and eight of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An Act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws," to be entitled "Garrett county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re enacted.

SECTION 22. That the commissioners of said county shall levy, annually, for the crier of the Circuit Court for said county, three dollars per day for his services as such crier; and the collector shall pay said crier at the close of each session of the court for his services during said session.

**Chapter 102.**

AN ACT authorizing Robert J. Waller, temporary guardian of Archie Waller, a minor, to pass his final account with the Orphans' Court for Somerset county.
