

Chapter 10.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to levy annually a sum of money for the relief of Henry Macatee, of Sylvester, of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Harford county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy and pay annually to Henry Macatee, of Sylvester, a sum of money not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Levy annually

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 11.

AN ACT to repeal section sixty-two of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Talbot county, sub-title "Easton," and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section sixty-two of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Talbot county, sub-title "Easton," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

62. The said commissioners may levy and collect from the owner or owners, keeper or keepers, a tax of one dollar on every dog, and two dollars on every bitch owned, kept or harbored in said town, and may authorize the killing of any dog or bitch, in default of the owner or owners to pay such tax, or whose owner or owners, keeper or keepers, cannot be ascertained.

Dog tax.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
