Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Robert J. Waller, temporary guardian of Archie Waller, be and is hereby authorized to pass his final account as temporary guardian, as aforesaid, and as administrator of the estate of Franklin E. Waller, deceased, before the Orphans' Court of Somerset county, and to pay and deliver over to the said Archie Waller all his property, real and personal, and moneys that may be due him on the said final account, and to take his receipt therefor, which shall be acknowledged and recorded in the office of the register of wills for said county, and have the same effect as if the same was executed by a person of full age.

Authorized to pass final account.

Answerable for debts.

SEC 2. And be it enacted, That from and after the passage of this act the said Archie Waller shall be answerable for all debts contracted and liabilities made and entered into by him, and may sue and be sued as fully as if he was of full age.

Effective.

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 103.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy a sum of money, as a pension, for Solomon Tate, of said county.

Levy for pension. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county, for the sum of thirty dollars, for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and the same amount for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, as a pension for Soloman Tate, of said county.
