of a mile thereof, or on Madison avenue extended, in said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective take effect from and after the date of its passage.

Chapter 108.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of School Commissioners for Baltimore county to pay to William H. Rimmey a certain sum of money.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, and in case the said board shall deem it just and proper, to pay to William H. Rimmey, of Baltimore county, the sum of three hundred and ninety-seven dollars and fifty cents, as compensation for an alleged loss sustained by the said William H. Rimmey in the erection of a school house, outbuildings and fence for the said Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore county, at Mount Winans, in the thirteenth election district of Baltimore county.

Compensation for alleged loss

SEC. 2. That this act take effect from the date of its passage.
