

Chapter 121.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to punish the sale or other disposition of Intoxicating Liquors on or near the graded road leading from the Western Maryland Railroad to High Rock in Washington county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons, licensed or unlicensed, directly or indirectly, to barter, sell, exchange, trade or deal in any kind of spirituous or fermented liquors or intoxicating drinks of any kind upon the graded road leading from the Western Maryland railroad to "High Rock" in Washington county, or at any place in this State within one-quarter of a mile from any part of said graded road, between said railroad and "High Rock," or within one-quarter of a mile of any building at "High Rock," or Pen Mar station, or to place or distribute any signs, cards or other devices inviting to the purchase, exchange or barter of any spirituous or fermented liquors or intoxicating drinks, or to solicit the purchase of the same within the limits of the one-quarter of a mile aforesaid.

Sale of intoxicating drinks prohibited.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That any person or persons violating the provisions of the preceding section shall be liable to indictment by the grand jury of Washington county, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every offence; one-half of the fine shall be paid to the informer, and the other half to the County Commissioners for the use of the public schools.

Fine for violation.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
