

Chapter 130.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 165 of the acts of the General Assembly, January session, 1865, entitled "An Act to repeal section 413 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the city of Baltimore, entitled 'Hay and Straw,' and to re-enact the same with an amendment," and to re-enact the same with amendments, so as to provide for the inspection and weighing of corn in the ear, and corn husks.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter 165 of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed January session, 1865, entitled "An Act to repeal section 413 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, of the city of Baltimore, entitled 'Hay and Straw,' and to re-enact the same with an amendment," be repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Re-enacted with amendment.

413. The said inspector shall be entitled to demand and receive for each and every load of hay and straw inspected by him, of whatever weight, one cent per hundred pounds; and for weighing hems, cable anchors, dye woods, barks, et cetera, two cents per hundred pounds; and for inspecting and weighing corn in the ear and corn husks, one cent per hundred pounds.

Compensation of inspector.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
