Chapter 135.

AN ACT to amend the first section of an act passed at the present session of this General Assembly, entitled "An Act to provide for the Uniform Registration of the names of all the qualified voters in this State, by adding thereto a sub-section, to be designated as sub-section 1A, specifically providing for the appointment of officers of registration in the counties of this State after the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the first section of this act, passed at the present session of this General Assembly, entitled "An Act to provide for the Uniform Registration of the names of all the qualified voters in this State," be amended by adding thereto the following sub-section, to be designated as sub-section 1A:

SUB-SEC. 1A. At each regular session of the General Assembly, to be held in every second year after the present session thereof, the Governor shall also nominate and, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, appoint one capable person in each election district of every county in this State, who shall be a voter and resident in the election district for which he shall be appointed, to be an officer of registration for the said election district.
