with all the power and authority in law had by the late treasurer and collector for that purpose.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall

Chapter 137.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments the second section of chapter four hundred and eighty-seven of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An Act supplementary to an act entitled 'An Act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county'" and for other purposes, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and five.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section two of an act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and eighty-seven, entitled "An Act supplementary to an act entitled 'An Act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes," passed at January session, eighteen hundred and five, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the "President, Managers and Company of the Baltimore and Reisterstown Turnpike Road" be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to cede and transfer, or sell to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, or to the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, or to the County Commissioners of Carroll county, or to the Mayor and City Council of Westminster, or any municipal corporation, upon such terms and conditions, and with such reservations as may be mutually agreed
