

authorized, empowered and directed to cause to be built a substantial bridge, to be of the width of not less than sixteen feet, over and across Mill Creek, in the third election district for said county, from the point on the north side of said creek on the land of Mrs. Eleanor B. Duvall, called and known as Deep Point, to the best point or location for a landing and road on the south side of said creek and as nearly opposite as may be to said Deep Point. And the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by inquisition, purchase or otherwise, all the lands and the materials necessary for the construction of the said bridge and its abutments, and for necessary and suitable roads leading to and from the same, for the convenience of public travel, and said bridge, when built, shall be maintained and kept in proper repair by the said County Commissioners as a free bridge.

Build substantial bridge.

Acquire by inquisition.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to levy on the assessable property of said county in such manner and at such time or times as they may deem best, such sums of money as may be necessary to carry out and secure the provisions of this act; provided, however, that such levy shall so be made as to complete said bridge and the roads suitable for public travel leading thereto during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, provided that the cost of said bridge and constructing necessary roads to reach the same and putting them in proper and legal condition for travel shall not exceed the sum of fifteen hundred dollars.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
