

thence with what is known as Hamill's line to the beginning. And all that portion of Garrett county described within the foregoing metes and bounds shall be known and designated as district number ten.

Present dividing line—how changed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the present dividing line between the third and fourth election districts of Garrett county be changed so as to run as follows: Beginning at the foot of Savage Mountain where the two county roads intersect, and running down said mountain to the head waters of Mill Run, then with said run to the dividing line between Allegany and Garrett counties, thence with said dividing line to district number nine, thence with said line to or near John Wilhelm's, at Little Savage, thence changing the dividing lines of numbers three and four to run as follows: Beginning at the bridge across Little Savage near John Wilhelm's and running with Barton and Lonaconing road and running with said road to Mrs. Hanson Brown's, on Pea Ridge, thence with said road down and across Pea Ridge to Henry Broadwater's, Jr., at the head of Harton Hollow, from thence across to William W. Broadwater's, thence across to the head waters of Bear Pen Run, thence with said run to Savage River, thence with said river to the old ford, from thence across said river running with the public road to the place of beginning. And all that portion of Garrett county as described in this section within the foregoing metes and bounds shall be known and described as district number eleven.

How known.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the place of holding elections in said districts numbers ten and eleven shall be for districts number ten at Deer Park, and for number eleven at "The Elbow," at the house of Joseph Warnick. And be it enacted, That the voting place of district number eight shall be moved from its present location at Fort Pendleton to Mrs. Thomas Grimes', on Northwestern Grade. And be it further enacted, That the voting place of district number one shall be moved from its present location, Altamont, to Swanton, on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the Governor shall appoint one justice of the peace and one register of voters for each of said districts; and the County Commissioners of Garrett county shall ap-
