

point one constable in and for said districts numbers ten and eleven.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said district, or districts numbers ten and eleven, shall be entitled in all respects to all the rights and privileges held or to be held or enjoyed by the other election districts in said county.

Rights and privileges.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett county shall furnish a proper book for registration, such as may be required by law, to be delivered to the register of voters for said district, or districts numbers ten and eleven; and the said clerk shall also at the same time deliver to said register of voters a full list, under seal of his office, of all registered persons, or voters, appearing on the registration book for the old districts numbers one, seven and eight, and from districts numbers three and four of Garrett county; and the said register of voters of said district, or districts numbers one, seven and eight, and numbers three and four, shall transcribe from said list and enter in alphabetical order in said book of registration for said new district, or districts numbers ten and eleven, the names of all persons living within the limits thereof entitled to vote in said district, or districts numbers ten and eleven, and likewise to register therein the names of all persons who shall become entitled to vote in said district, or districts numbers ten and eleven, according to the laws of this State.

Transcribe list.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the officers of registration of districts numbers one, seven and eight, and numbers three and four, to strike from the list of qualified voters on the registration books thereof the names of all persons residing within the limits of and entitled to vote in said district, or districts numbers ten and eleven.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
