

Chapter 158.

AN ACT to refund to John G. England, Jr., executor of Ursula Wilcoxon, of Montgomery county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the treasury of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant on the treasurer of Maryland, to pay to John G. England, Jr., executor of Ursula Wilcoxon, of Montgomery county, the sum of twenty-three dollars and sixty two cents, erroneously paid by him in the settlement of the estate of said deceased, as is certified by the judges of the Orphans court of said county and the register thereof.

Directed to issue warrant.

Chapter 159.

AN ACT to provide for surveying and marking the boundary line between the States of Maryland and Virginia as ascertained and determined by the arbitrators heretofore appointed on the part of said States respectively, and to appropriate a sum of money to mark the said line and erect the necessary monuments thereon.

WHEREAS the arbitrators to whom were submitted the controversies between the States of Maryland and Virginia concerning their territorial limits, have filed their award determining and declaring the boundary line of the said States, so far as they are coterminous; and whereas the said boundary line, so as aforesaid determined, has been accepted by the States of Virginia and Maryland respectively, and has also been ratified by the Congress of the United States as required by the Constitution of the United States; and whereas it is necessary that said boundary line should be sur-
