Increase capital stock. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the Board of Directors of said association shall have power to increase the capital stock thereof to the amount of one hundred thousand dollars, or any part thereof, in shares of one thousand dollars each, and receive subscriptions therefor at any time, and such additional stock shall be subject to all the liabilities, rights, immunities and privileges of the original stock.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That said association be, and it is hereby empowered, in its discretion, to subscribe for and otherwise acquire so much as it may see fit of the capital stock of "Mountain Lake Park Hotel Company," and to participate in the organization and government of the same, provided always that the powers granted by this section shall be exercised subject to the limitations imposed by

the charter of this last mentioned corporation.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the limitation to the existence of "Mountain Lake Park Association of Garrett county," required by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter four hundred and seventy-one, section thirty-seven, be and the same is.

hereby rescinded.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That no license shall be issued by any authority for the sale or barter in any way of spirituous or malt liquors, wine or cider, on the grounds of said association, or within one mile thereof.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
