Chapter 166.

AN ACT to authorize the clerk of the Circuit Court for Dorchester county to make a General Index of all the Land Records of his office.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Dorchester county be and he is hereby authorized and required, under the supervision and direction of the resident judge of said court, to make or have made a General Index of all the Land Records of his office, and to provide a book or books proper and requisite for such purpose.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Dorchester county be and they are hereby directed to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sufficient sum to pay for said general index and said book or books.
