

of such crossing or crossings in the manner and with the powers for the condemnation of property prescribed and granted by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, and entitled "An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Western Maryland Railroad Company and to give additional powers to said company."

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage. Effective.

Chapter 177.

AN ACT supplementary to chapter thirty-four of the acts of the January session of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and to confirm an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, entitled "An ordinance supplementary to an ordinance passed December the twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and fifty-three," entitled "An ordinance to aid the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company by a loan of five millions of dollars to complete their road to the city of Wheeling, fund their debts, and especially to lay a double track as far as Piedmont, two hundred and eighteen miles from Baltimore, and to confer upon the Mayor and City Council and the Commissioners of Finance and the Register of said city the powers necessary for carrying into effect the provisions of said supplementary ordinance."

WHEREAS there was enacted by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore an ordinance approved the fifth day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-one, in the terms following, that is to say: Preamble.
