## Chapter 190.

AN ACT requiring the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to condemn, open and repair the road or way now called Clinton street, at Canton, in that county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby directed to condemn, open and repair the road or way now called Clinton street, at Canton, or so much thereof as they may consider necessary for the public convenience.

Condemn, open and repair.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective.

## Chapter 191.

AN ACT to pay a sum of money to Richard H. Green for services as Clerk and Secretary to the Board of Public Works of the State of Maryland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer, in favor of Richard H. Green, for the sum of six hundred dollars, for two years' salary up to the first day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, as clerk and secretary to the Board of Public Works of the State of Maryland.
