

and also to Rev. M. J. Allaman, of York, in the county of York, and State of Pennsylvania, the sum of two hundred dollars, and all the balance of her estate not otherwise bequeathed ; therefore—

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above-mentioned devises and bequests of said Elizabeth Catharine Erb, deceased.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 194.

AN ACT to prevent the trespass upon private property in Kent county, in this State, by any person or persons who have been forbidden to do so by a special written notice served upon him, her or them by the owner or owners of said private property or by their agents.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any person or persons who shall enter upon or cross over the private property of any person or persons in Kent county, in this State, after having had a special written notice served upon him, her or them by the owner or owners of said property, or by his, her or their agent, not to cross over or enter upon said private property, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof before some justice of the peace of said county, be fined by said justice not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars, and in default of the payment of said fine, together with the costs of prosecution, shall be by said justice of the peace committed to the county jail for a period of ten days.

Not to cross private property.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all fines collected under the foregoing section shall be paid
