Chapter 198.

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Sarah Patten, late of Cecil county, deceased, to the Trustees of the Rock Run Church, Presbyterian, of Cecil county.

Sanction and consent.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland is hereby given to the bequest of Sarah Patten, late of Cecil county, deceased, to the Trustees of the Rock Run Church, Presbyterian, of Cecil county.

Chapter 199.

AN ACT to prohibit gunning on "Eastern Avenue Bridge," crossing Back river, in Baltimore county.

Unlawful.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to shoot a gun, guns or other firearms from and off of "Eastern Avenue Bridge," crossing Back river, situated in Baltimore county.

Issue warrant for arrest.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That upon information given upon oath or affirmation to any justice of the peace of said county, or to the Circuit Court for said county, of any violation of any of the provisions of this act, said justice of the peace or said Circuit Court shall issue a warrant for the arrest of the offender or offenders, and for the seizure of the gun,
