SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Board of Public Works are hereby authorized, in their judgment, to sell or otherwise, or dispose of said sloop Mary Compton, and the proceeds from said sale to pay into the State Treasury.

### Chapter 204.

AN ACT to repeal the first section of chapter forty-two of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of wild fowl from sink boxes in certain parts of Sassafras river, in Cecil and Kent counties," west of a line drawn from Pond's Bar, on the Kent side, to Ordinary Point Bar, on the Cecil side, and to re-enact the said first section with amendments.

Repealed and  
re-enacted.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the first section of chapter forty-two of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of wild fowl from sink boxes in certain parts of Sassafras river, in Cecil and Kent counties, west of a line drawn from Pond's Bar, on the Kent side, to Ordinary Point Bar, on the Cecil side," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

When lawful.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That on and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for the *bona fide* citizens of Cecil and Kent counties to shoot wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of the Sassafras river, in said counties, from the first day of November, in each year, until the thirty-first day of March next
