

Chapter 211.

AN ACT to authorize the clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county to copy the General Index to Land Records in his office from eighteen hundred and thirty-three to eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

WHEREAS the General Index to Land Record Books in the Circuit Court for Talbot county, from the year eighteen hundred and thirty-three to eighteen hundred and sixty-four, is defective, incomplete and unreliable; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the clerk of the Circuit Court for Talbot county be and he is hereby authorized to copy said index in a good and substantial book from eighteen hundred and thirty-three to eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

Copy index.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the compensation to the said clerk for copying said record be the same as the law now allows for recording anything required by law to be recorded in his office.

Compensation.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the Commissioners of Talbot county be and they are hereby authorized to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sum not exceeding three hundred and fifty dollars, to pay the expenses of recopying as aforesaid in section two of this act.

Levy upon assessable property.

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
