Chapter 213.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Spencer C. Jones.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed and requested to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay Spencer C. Jones the sum of two thousand and forty-six dollars and eighty-five cents for fees due him as clerk of the Court of Appeals, this claim and the proof thereof having been reported upon by the Comptroller.

Chapter 214.

AN ACT to amend article six, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline county," subtitle "County Commissioners," by adding additional sections thereto, authorizing the appointment and election of a Treasurer for said county; also the borrowing of money and the issuing of bonds therefor.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Caroline county be and are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to appoint a Treasurer for the said county, who shall also be clerk to the said county commissioners, who shall hold his office from the time of his appointment and qualification until the first Monday in January, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four; and be it further enacted that the Commissioners of Caroline county, after the first meeting after the next general election to be held in the year eighteen hundred.
