Entitled to property.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said "Shelter for Aged and Infirm Colored Persons of Baltimore city" shall, by virtue of this act, be entitled to any property or rights which by any will already executed or hereafter executed may be devised or bequeathed to or in trust for the said Shelter for Orphans of Colored Soldiers and Friendless Children of Baltimore city.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## Chapter 218.

AN ACT to authorize the reorganization of the Liberty and New Windsor Turnpike Company, in Frederick and Carroll counties, upon the happening of certain contingencies therein specified.

Whereas by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter ninetyfour, the Liberty and New Windsor Turnpike Company, in Frederick and Carroll counties, a body politic and corporate of this State, incorporated under an act of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter ninetysix and its supplements, was authorized and empowered to issue its bonds to an amount not to exceed fifteen thousand dollars to aid in the construction of its road and for any indebtedness of said company then due and owing on account of the building, construction or pairs of said turnpike road, whether for work done, materials provided or money loaned, and to secure the same by mortgage on its property and rights of property of all kinds and descriptions, real, personal and mixed, including its franchise as a corporation, said act to take effect and to be in force from and after the date of its acceptance
