each of said election precincts, and of performing all other duties devolved upon him by law, from the first Monday of September inclusive of said day in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, for fifteen successive days, Sundays excepted, and shall sit in like manner, and for the same purposes, for three successive days, commencing with and including the first Monday in October in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three shall sit in like manner, and for the same purposes, from the first Monday of September inclusive of said day, for fifteen successive days, Sundays excepted; and shall sit in like manner, and for the same purposes, for three successive days, commencing with and including the first Monday in October in said last mentioned year; and the officer of registration appointed for each ward of the city of Baltimore after the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and beginning in the year eighteen hundred and eightyfour, shall sit in like manner for the purpose of revising the registry of voters and poll-books, or list of qualified and registered voters, in each of the election precincts in the ward of which he may be an officer of registration, from the first Monday of September inclusive of said day in said last mentioned year, for fifteen successive days, Sundays excepted; and for three successive days, commencing with and including the first Monday in October, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four, and shall sit at and for the same periods of time, and for the same purposes, in each succeeding year; the said respective officers of registration shall sit at said respective sittings in the city of Baltimore, with open doors, from eight o'clock A. M. to seven o'clock P. M. on each day of their said appointed sittings.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That each of the said officers of registration appointed for an election district in any county of this State shall endorse upon the back and write at the head of each registry of voters and of each poll-book delivered to him as aforesaid, the name of the county and the number or name of the election district, or the name of the county and the number or name of the election district and of the election precinct in such election
