

the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter thirty-one, defining "Tramps," and prescribing their punishment, or as the same may be amended by any act supplementary thereto, or amendatory thereof; and to hear, try and determine the cases of all persons arrested and brought before him charged with any offence specified in article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Disturbance of the Public Peace," as the same was enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter twenty-two, defining certain offences tending to the disturbance of the public peace in the city of Baltimore; and to hear, try and determine the cases of all persons arrested and brought before him, charged with any offence specified in article thirty of the Public General Laws of this State, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Drunkenness," as the same was enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter twenty-four; and to hear, try and determine the cases of all persons arrested and brought before him, charged with any offence made punishable by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and seventy-three, amending article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Vagrants," or by any act supplementary thereto, or amendatory thereof, and to hear, try and determine all prosecutions or criminal proceedings brought before him for any act done, or omitted to be done, in the city of Baltimore, the doing of which act, or the omission to do which act, is or may be punishable under any act of Assembly of this State, or under any ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, by a pecuniary fine only, not exceeding in amount the sum of one hundred dollars; it is, however, hereby expressly provided that the said justices shall not have power to try and determine any violation of article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws of this State, title "Licenses," except violations of sub-title "Hawkers and Pedlers" of said last named article, which they shall have jurisdiction to try and determine; and shall not have power to try and determine any violations of sub-title "Sabbath Breaking" of article thirty of said Code of Public General Laws;
